



December 2018 Update

62nd Avenue N. Roadway Improvements

Project Overview

Pinellas County Public Works has planned corridor improvements for the widening of 62nd Avenue N., from 49th Street N. to 34th Street N. in St. Petersburg. The project objective is to increase intersection capacity at congested locations, provide a center turn lane, and provide multimodal improvements for bicyclists, pedestrians and transit users. The project is identified as the No. 3 priority in the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) for Penny IV projects, funded through the county's local infrastructure sales tax.

The resulting project will reduce congestion, improve safety and support alternative transportation options for citizens and businesses in the area.

Project Schedule – Next Steps

- Study Start: December 2017
- Study End: May 2019
- Design: To be determined upon completion of study
- Construction: To be determined upon completion of study

This project's study is funded through the Penny for Pinellas program, the county's local infrastructure sales tax.

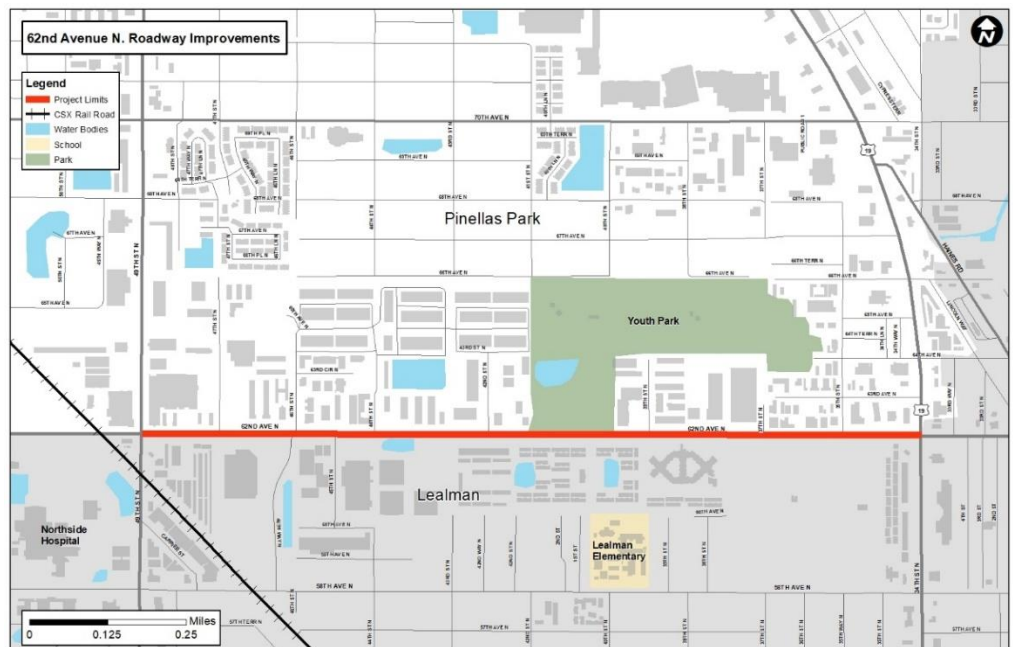
