Pinellas County is hosting an open house event on Thursday, June 6, 2019 to provide information regarding the planned water quality improvements at the County-owned Eagle Lake Park, 1690 S. Keene Road, Largo, outlined in yellow on the map below. County and engineering consultant representatives will be available to answer questions. The project is intended to improve water quality by improving circulation and diverting untreated stormwater runoff into the Park's constructed wetland for treatment prior to flowing into Allen's Creek and ultimately into Tampa Bay.

The intent of the open house is to make you aware of the planned water quality related improvements at Eagle Lake Park and obtain any feedback you may have. ## Project Schedule

The design phase of the project is at about 30%. Survey crews will be working within the Park beginning in May/June 2019. The project is programmed in the Pinellas County Capital Improvement Program and is currently funded for construction beginning in 2020. These improvements are being paid for by the Penny for Pinellas program with partial funding through a Tampa Bay Environmental Restoration Fund Grant Agreement administered by the Tampa Bay Estuary Program.
