I RECOMMEND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS (BOARD) REJECT THE PROPOSAL FROM E. L. TREVENA INC., PINELLAS PARK, FLORIDA ON THE BASIS OF BEING NON-RESPONSIVE FOR NOT MEETING PROPOSAL SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS.

IT IS FURTHER RECOMMENDED THE BOARD AWARD A CONTRACT TO ASHBRIITT, INC., POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA AS THE PRIMARY CONTRACTOR FOR DISASTER DEBRIS REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL, ON THE BASIS OF BEING THE HIGHEST RANKED PROPOSAL RECEIVED.

IT IS ALSO RECOMMENDED AWARD BE MADE TO DRC EMERGENCY SERVICES, LLC, MOBILE, ALABAMA AND OMNI PINNACLE, LLC, SLIDELL, LOUISIANA AS SECONDARY CONTRACTORS FOR DISASTER DEBRIS REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL, ON THE BASIS OF BEING THE SECOND AND THIRD HIGHEST RANKED FIRMS. PROPOSALS ARE ON FILE IN THE PURCHASING DEPARTMENT.

IT IS ADDITIONALLY RECOMMENDED THAT AFTER PROPER EXECUTION OF THE AGREEMENTS BY THE CONTRACTORS, THE CHAIRMAN BE AUTHORIZED TO SIGN AND THE CLERK TO ATTEST.

Summary Explanation/Background:

In April, 2007, the Purchasing Department, on behalf of Solid Waste, let a Request For Proposal (RFP) for Disaster Debris Removal and Disposal. A committee, consisting of members from the Solid Waste Department (the evaluator from an outside department was unable to attend), along with two (2) members of the Purchasing Department acting in an advisory capacity, met on May 18, 2007, to evaluate and score the proposals received according to the following criteria:

The committee agreed to accept the proposals and make a recommendation for award to the number one ranked firm, AshBritt, Inc. as the primary and sole contractor responsible for the collection, storage, processing, disposal and the recycling of debris generated from a natural disaster, such as a hurricane. If the disaster is of such magnitude that the primary contractor is unable to perform on its own, then the second and third ranked firms, DRC Emergency Services, LLC and Omni Pinnacle, LLC will be used to provide additional support.

Proposals were received from fourteen (14) firms and their order of ranking is as follows:

This is a five (5) year contract with potential yearly price adjustments in an amount not to exceed the average of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all urban consumers, not seasonally adjusted, for the period of twelve months, or five percent, whichever is less. This contract has an additional two (2) year renewal, if the terms and conditions remain the same, pending County Administrator approval.

Funds will be provided through Reserves for contingencies within the impacted fund(s). A portion of the costs incurred may be offset with reimbursement from the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2007, by and between PINELLAS COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "County", represented by its Board of County Commissioners, and ASHBRIIT, INC., hereinafter referred to as the primary "Contractor".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, County has previously determined that it has a need for DISASTER DEBRIS REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL; and

WHEREAS, County, after soliciting competitive proposals for such services pursuant to Pinellas County Request for Proposal, RFP No. 067-0331-P (hereinafter Request for Proposal or RFP), County has awarded this contract to Contractor; and

WHEREAS, Contractor has represented that it is able to satisfactorily provide the services according to the terms and conditions of the Request for Proposal, which are incorporated herein by reference, and the terms and conditions contained herein; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above and mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Services to be Performed. The Contractor hereby agrees to provide the County with DISASTER DEBRIS REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL, as requested and more specifically outlined in the Request for Proposal, this Agreement and all subsequent official documents that form the Contract Documents for this Agreement.

2. Time of Service. Services shall be performed in a timely manner, as specified in the Request for Proposal.

3. Term of Agreement/Option of Renewal. Services performed pursuant to this Contract shall commence upon execution of this agreement and continue for a period of FIVE (5) years, unless canceled or terminated as provided herein. This Contract may be renewed, by written agreement of the parties, for TWO (2) additional TWELVE (12) month period(s) after the initial contract period. This option shall be exercised only if all terms and conditions remain the same, and approval is granted by the County Administrator or Director of Purchasing.

4. Amendment of the Contract. This Contract may be amended only by mutual written agreement of the parties.

5. Assignment/Subcontracting. The Contractor shall perform this contract. No assignment or subcontracting shall be allowed without the prior written consent of the County. In the event of a corporate acquisition and/or merger, the Contractor shall provide written notice to the County within thirty (30) business days of Contractor's notice of such action or upon the occurrence of said action, whichever occurs first. The right to terminate this contract, which shall not be unreasonably exercised by the County, shall include, but not be limited to, instances in which a corporate acquisition and/or merger represent a conflict of interest or are contrary to any local, state or federal laws. Action by the County awarding a proposal to a proposer which has disclosed its intent to assign or subcontract in its response to the RFP, without exception shall constitute approval for purposes of this Agreement.

6. Cancellation. Pinellas County reserves the right to cancel this Contract, without cause, by giving thirty (30) days prior written notice to the Contractor of the intention to cancel, or with cause if at any time the Contractor fails to fulfill or abide by any of the terms or conditions specified.

Failure of the Contractor to comply with any of the provisions of this contract shall be considered a material breach of contract and shall be cause for immediate termination of the contract at the discretion of Pinellas County.

In addition to all other legal remedies available to County, County reserves the right to cancel and obtain from another source any services which have not been provided within the period of time stated in the proposal, or if no such time is stated, within a reasonable period of time from the date of order or request, as determined by County.

In addition, in the event that sufficient budgeted funds are not available for a new fiscal period, the County shall notify the Contractor of such occurrence and the Contract shall terminate on the last day of the then current fiscal period without penalty or expense to the County.

7. Compensation. As compensation for the Contractor providing services to the County as described herein, the County shall pay the Contractor per the terms of the RFP, based on the submission of invoices for work done. All payments shall be made in accordance with the Florida Prompt Payment Act, Fla. Stat. Contract renewals will allow for price adjustments in an amount not to exceed the average of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all Urban Consumers, Not Seasonally Adjusted, for the twelve

months prior to renewal, or five (5) percent, whichever is less. Unit price adjustments shall be consistent with the latest FEMA guidelines for labor, equipment, collection and processing.

8. Permits/ Licenses. Contractor must secure and maintain any and all permits and licenses required to complete this contract.

9. Audit. The Contractor shall retain all records relating to this contract for a period of at least three (3) years after final payment is made. All records shall be kept in such a way as will permit their inspection pursuant to Chapter 119, Florida Statutes. In addition, Pinellas County reserves the right to audit such records pursuant to Pinellas County Code, Chapter 2.

10. Minimum Insurance Requirements. The Contractor must maintain insurance in at least the amounts required in the Request for Proposal throughout the term of this contract. The contractor must provide a Certificate of Insurance in accordance with Insurance Requirements, Section C of the Request for Proposal, evidencing such coverage prior to issuance of a purchase order or commencement of any work under this Contract. Contractor shall ensure that any subcontractors or persons hired by subcontractors maintain the same level of insurance coverage as the contractor.

11. Indemnification. Contractor shall indemnify, pay the cost of defense, including attorneys' fees, and hold harmless the County from all suits, actions or claims of any character brought on account of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person, persons or property by or from the said Contractor; or by, or in consequence of any neglect in safeguarding the work; or by the use of unacceptable materials in the construction of improvements; or by or on account of any act or omission, neglect or misconduct of the said Contractor; or by, or on account of, any claim or amounts recovered under the "Workers' Compensation Law" or of any other laws, by-laws, ordinance, order or decree, except only such injury or damage as shall have been occasioned by the sole negligence of the County. The first ten dollars (\$10.00) of compensation received by the Contractor represents specific consideration for this indemnification obligation.

12. Governing Law. The laws of the State of Florida shall govern this Agreement.

13. Independent Contractor Status and Compliance with the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986. The Contractor is and shall remain an independent contractor and is neither agent, employee, partner, nor joint venturer of County. Contractor acknowledges that it is responsible for

complying with the provisions of the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986 located at 8 U.S.C. 1324, et. seq., and regulations relating thereto, as either may be amended from time to time. Failure to comply with the above provisions shall be considered a material breach and shall be grounds for immediate termination of the Contract, at the discretion of Pinellas County.

14. Severability. The terms and conditions of this agreement shall be deemed to be severable. Consequently, if any clause, term, or condition hereof shall be held to be illegal or void, such determination shall not affect the validity or legality of the remaining terms and conditions, and notwithstanding any such determination, this agreement shall continue in full force and effect unless the particular clause, term, or condition held to be illegal or void renders the balance of the agreement impossible to perform.

15. Documents Comprising Contract. The Contract shall include this Agreement for DISASTER DEBRIS REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL, as well as the following documents, which are incorporated herein by reference.

- a. Pinellas County's Request for Proposal and all of its addenda and attachments issued on May 8, 2007;
- b. Contractor's Certificate of Insurance required under Section C of the Request for Proposal;
- c. Contractor's Proposal.

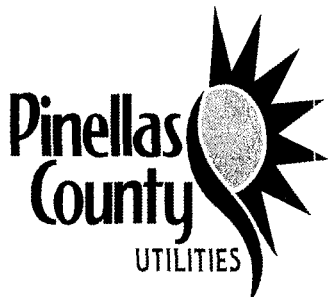

The Solid Waste Department has solicited and received RFPs for Disaster Debris Removal and Disposal, Contract # 067-0331-P (TS). Fourteen proposals were received and subsequently reviewed by Solid Waste staff along with staff from the Purchasing Department.

The RFP was written so that more than one contract could be awarded. The intent is to have a primary contractor that would be utilized for all anticipated events. However, should the nature of the event be of such magnitude that the primary contractor was unable to provide all the resources required the County will be able to bring in additional resources through the additional contracts.

Based on the results of the consensus evaluation meeting, I recommend award of the RFP to Ashbritt, Inc as the primary contractor and to DRC Emergency Services, LLC and Omni Pinnacle, LLC as secondary contractors.
