### **ADDENDUM NO. 1**

Following is additional information, clarifications, questions and responses relative to referenced Request for Proposal (RFP):

#### **QUESTIONS:**


1. Question: Please confirm that per the RFQ (pg. 11), if the applicant firm **or** its sub-consultants are certified as a minority business by the State of Florida, five percent of the total evaluation points (50 points) will be awarded to the applicant firm.  
**Response: Yes.**
2. While we cannot use current Pinellas County staff as a reference, are we permitted to use past (former) Pinellas County employees as a reference?  
**Response: Current – No. Past – Yes.**
3. Are Landscape Architecture services anticipated to be needed for this contract?  
**Response: That is up to the consultant to determine.**
4. In determining the “Volume of Work” score, will the County take into consideration only monies that are awarded to a Firm directly by the County, or will it consider monies awarded to a Firm as a sub-consultant on County projects? Example – a team consisting of a DBE firm working under a non-DBE prime has done work on a County project recently, but for this pursuit, the DBE firm is listed as the prime with the non-DBE firm listed as the sub; allowing the team to avoid being impacted for the past volume of work. Does this strategy meet the equitable distribution of work intended by CCNA?  
**Response: Points are determined by award of the prime firm only.**
