Approval of Ranking of Consultant Selection - South Cross Bayou Reclamation Facility UV Disinfection System and Related Improvements

I RECOMMEND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS (BOARD) APPROVE THE RANKING OF FIRMS AND AUTHORIZE STAFF TO NEGOTIATE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NUMBER ONE RANKED FIRM, PARSONS WATER & INFRASTRUCTURE, INC. (PARSONS), TAMPA, FLORIDA FOR SOUTH CROSS BAYOU RECLAMATION FACILITY UV DISINFECTION SYSTEM AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS.

Summary Explanation/Background:

On April 1, 2011, in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) policy, the Purchasing Department on behalf of the Utilities Department let a Request for Proposal (RFP) with the intent of obtaining the services of a qualified firm to perform preliminary engineering, final design and construction services for improvements to the South Cross Bayou Water Reclamation Facility. The firm selected will be tasked with review and validation of existing information, and related piping, mechanical, electrical, structural, and other miscellaneous work necessary to complete the project on time and within budget. The RFP is a result of the County's receipt of a consent order from Florida Department of Environmental Protection mandating the County to reduce certain disinfection byproduct concentrations in effluent discharged to Joe's Creek.

The evaluation committee consisting of two (2) representatives from the Utilities Department, two (2) representatives from the Real Estate Management Department (REM), and one (1) representative from the Department of Public Works, along with a representative from the Purchasing Department acting as a facilitator, met on June 13, 2011, to evaluate and score the seven (7) proposals received.

The committee evaluated the firms written qualifications per the criteria detailed below:

5.	CH2M Hill, Inc., Tampa, Florida	720.00 POINTS
6.	URS Corporation Southern, d/b/a URS, Tampa, Florida	638.50 POINTS
7.	Metzger & Willard, Inc., Tampa, Florida	577.25 POINTS

The evaluation committee recommended the first four (4) ranked proposers be invited to an oral presentation which was conducted on July 8, 2011.

The final ranking following the oral presentation is as follows:

1.	Parsons Water & Infrastructure, Inc. Tampa, Florida	906.00 POINTS
2.	Hazen and Sawyer, P.C., Tampa, Florida	839.00 POINTS
3.	Greeley and Hansen, Tampa, Florida	796.00 POINTS
4.	Wade Trim, Inc., Tampa, Florida	736.00 POINTS

At the direction of the Board, staff will begin negotiations with the highest ranked firm, Parsons, in accordance with County CCNA procedures. A final negotiated contract will be presented to the Board for consideration at a future date.

Fiscal Impact/Cost/Revenue Summary:

The budget estimate for this project is \$22,900,000.00. The cost estimate for services to be provided by Parsons prior to negotiations is \$1.5 to \$2.1 million. It is estimated that \$400,000.00 will be provided from Fund/Cost Center 0555/6652200 for FY11 and the balance of the project will be funded from Fund/Cost Center 0552/6614900 from FY12 through FY13.
