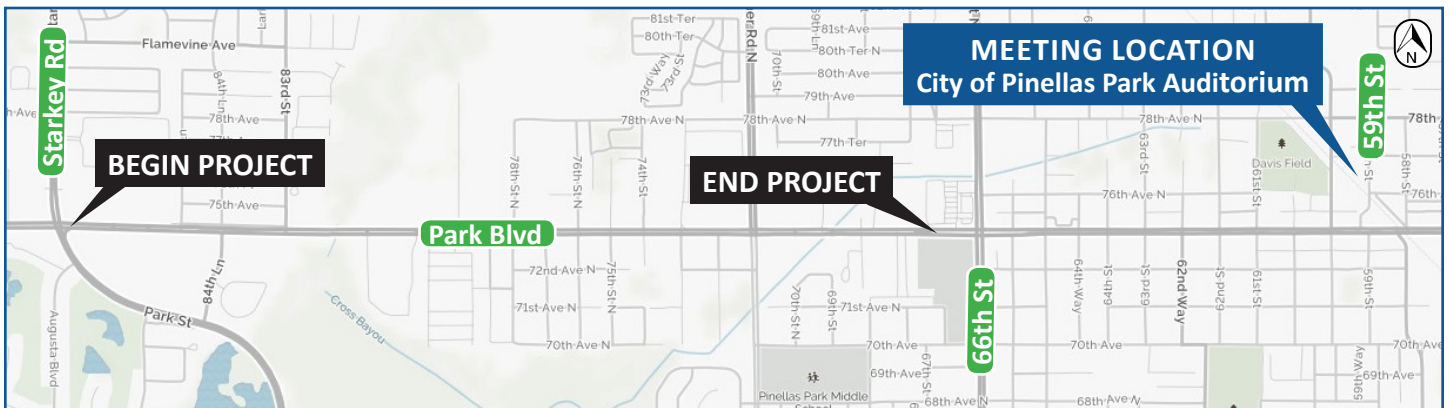
Pinellas County (County) is hosting a neighborhood meeting on Wednesday, March 7, 2018 to provide information regarding the planned sidewalk improvements along Park Boulevard (CR 694) from east of Starkey Road to west of 66th Street. The limits of the project fall within the Cities of Seminole and Pinellas Park. County representatives will be available at this meeting to review the proposed improvements and answer questions. The project primarily focuses on improving and upgrading the existing sidewalk in order to be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). This will include modifications to existing driveways where they intersect with the existing sidewalks, upgrades to the existing pedestrian curb ramps at side streets, and the replacement of broken or deficient sidewalk along the corridor. In addition, the project will include upgrading the existing mid-block pedestrian crossing at 79th Street North (at the Wagon Wheel Flea Market) to a full pedestrian signal, improving pedestrian accessibility on 74th Avenue North (Frontage Road) by upgrading the existing sidewalk and adding designated parking lanes, as well as upgrading the existing pedestrian signals where Park Boulevard intersects with 83rd Street North and Belcher Road.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Over the past several months, the project activities included data collection, field survey, development of roadway and sidewalk improvement plans, permitting and utility coordination. The project is programmed in the Pinellas County Capital Improvement Program and is currently funded for construction in Spring 2019. These improvements are being paid for by a Local Agency Program (LAP) Federal Grant administered by the Florida Department of Transportation.
