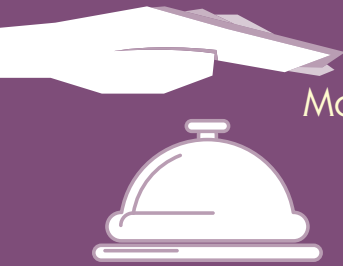

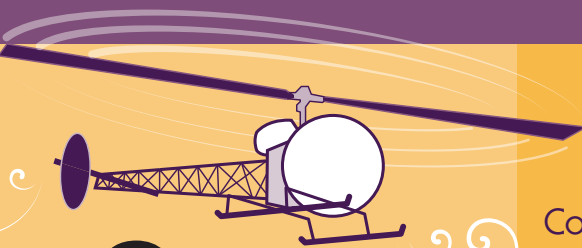

Arbovirus Control:

- Zika
- Dengue
- Chikungunya
- Eastern Equine Encephalitis
- St. Louis Encephalitis
- West Nile Virus
- Malaria
- Dog Heartworm



Arbovirus Response:

- **80 cases of Zika** under investigation (23 deemed as positive by Florida DOH in Pinellas County)
- 2 cases of Chikungunya
- 1 case of Dengue
