



## Event Recycling

### Green your event by recycling!

*You can recycle at any event, including festivals, block parties, or weddings.*

- For a **small event**, put “Recycle Here” signs on a few trash cans, and take the collected items to the nearest [drop-off recycling center](http://www.pinellascounty.org/recycle) or place in your home recycling container.
- For a **large event**, arrange recycling with a provider (see below). You can borrow bins or pay a private company to provide bins.

### Event Recycling Providers

**Recyclin’ Roadie** - Contact Pinellas County Solid Waste to schedule the Pinellas County Recyclin’ Roadie for events hosting 200 to 1,000 attendees. This brightly-painted, mobile recycling trailer holds everything you need to provide recycling at your event. The trailers are dropped off and picked up free of charge. Simply place the 32-gallon bright blue recycling bins around your event next to the trash cans, then load the containers and the recyclables back into the roadie once the event concludes.
