

Pinellas County Solid Waste Facility Information Sheet

SCALEHOUSE HOURS

Effective date 01/01/18

All loads must be covered!

- Open Monday - Friday 6 am - 6 pm and Saturday 7 am - 5 pm
- Closed Sundays, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day
- Reduced hours on certain holidays (*visit website*)

DISPOSAL FEE: \$37.50 per ton

(See below for tire disposal fees)

FLAT FEES*

The flat fee is not available if modifications have been made to the vehicle (*including sidewalls*)

- Pickup trucks & vans **\$10/load**
- Cars **\$2/load**
- Christmas trees only-up to 5 **\$3/load**

***All others weigh in and out, paying \$37.50 per ton.**

TIRE FEES

- Less than 5 tires charged at above disposal fees
- 5 or more tires weigh in and out at . . . **\$50.50/ton**
- Mixed loads containing tires **\$50.50/ton**
- Tires up to 36": Accepted whole
- Tires over 36": Must be cut into quarters
- Up to 2 tires can be attached to rim; all others must have rim removed
- No tractor trailer tires

SPECIAL FEES

- Load Search Fee **\$100**
- Special Waste Fee. **\$100**

REQUIRED DEPOSIT

- 50% of total loaded vehicle weight
- Deposit on credit cards may be held 3-5 business days based on policy of issuing bank

ACCEPTED PAYMENT METHODS

- Cash or credit cards- Visa or MasterCard only
- Checks-excluding starter checks, out-of-state personal checks, or two-party checks

BOATS

- Accepted under 24' in length, without motor, fluids, electronics or fuel tank
- Must be able to remove boat from vehicle without assistance from contractor or the county

FUEL CONTAINERS

- EMPTY fuel tanks and drums are accepted with one end open and are subject to inspection
- EMPTY cylinders are accepted with valve removed

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- NO hazardous waste** • NO gasoline or fuel oil**
- NO radioactive waste • NO liquid waste
- NO biological waste • NO explosives
- NO infectious waste

** Accepted at HEC₃ from residents (see reverse)
