### Building / Demolition Materials

*flooring, doors, electrical fixtures, plumbing, lumber, lighting fixtures, windows, roofing materials, gutters, gypsum board, HVAC/AC units, or tools*

1. **Recycle** building materials as part of the demolition process:
  - a) Earn points toward Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certification by recycling materials instead of disposing them. For information, visit [U.S. Green Building Council](#).
  - b) For information on salvaging building materials, including [A Guide to Deconstruction](#) (93 pages, 2 MB pdf), visit [Deconstruction Institute](#).
  - c) If the building is to be replaced, contact the manufacturer of new materials being purchased to ask if they accept old materials for recycling.

2. **Sell or donate** to a building material recycler that accepts a variety of materials:

3. **Sell or donate:**

- a) Use [Freecycle](#). Sign up for a local group (Clearwater, Clearwater Beach, North Pinellas, Largo, or St. Petersburg), and list your items for donation.
- b) Use [Craigslist Free Stuff](#) to donate items, or [Craigslist For Sale](#) to sell items. Select “post” to list your items.
- c) Free newspaper ad in the [St. Petersburg Times](#) (3-line limit).
