Cabinets / Counters

cabinet: storage unit or cupboard with shelves and drawers

counter: level surface on top of a cabinet

1. **Reduce** waste when upgrading cabinets by refacing them (keep the frames and replace only the doors).
2. **Reuse** cabinets or counters instead of trashing them:
 - a) Carefully disassemble the unit.
 - b) Utilize it elsewhere such as in the garage or laundry room.
3. **Sell** or **donate** to a [building material recycler](#).
4. **Dispose**.

 - c) Drop off at [Solid Waste Operations](#) (\$37.50/ton or flat rate for qualifying vehicles).
