Carpet / Carpet Pad

floor coverings made of natural or synthetic material

1. **Keep** the carpet if possible by repairing, cleaning, or dyeing it (see “Carpet & Rug – Repair,” “Carpet & Rug Cleaners,” and “Carpet & Rug – Dyers” in the Yellow Pages).
2. **Ask** the installer to haul away your old carpet and pad if you have new carpet installed.
3. **Sell** to a used rug dealer (primarily Oriental carpets). See “Carpet & Rug – Used” in the Yellow Pages.
4. **Sell** or **donate** to a [building material recycler](#).
5. **Businesses** with large quantities of commercial carpet or padding can contact:
