Cartons

*gable-top paper beverage containers such as milk or juice cartons;
drink boxes used for beverages such as juice (also called aseptic packaging)*

1. **Reduce** waste if you don't have carton recycling in your neighborhood by substituting plastic containers. Avoid single-serving drink boxes by using refillable beverage containers.
2. **Reuse** cartons:
 - a) [bird feeder](#)
 - b) seed starter (cut off the top, poke holes in the bottom, add soil, plant seeds)
 - c) disposable paint holder
 - d) ice block for a cooler
 - e) [craft ideas](#)
3. **Recycle** at curbside or drop-off in the cities serviced by Waste Management:
