Construction Debris:

Asphalt / Bricks / Concrete / Gravel / Rocks / Sand

aggregate or construction materials

1. **Reuse** sand to create sand bags during hurricane season.
2. **Donate** usable materials, such as bricks:
 - a) Use [Freecycle](#)—Sign up for a local group (Clearwater, Clearwater Beach, North Pinellas, Largo, or St. Petersburg), and list your items.
 - b) Use [Craigslist Free Stuff](#)—Select “post” to list your items.
3. **Dispose** at a local [rubble recycler](#). Some items are accepted at no charge, such as clean concrete.
4. **Dispose:**
 - a) Residents living in municipalities, see [Bulk Item Disposal by Municipality](#) for contact information.
 - b) Residents not living in municipalities, see [Bulk Item Disposal for Unincorporated Areas](#) for a list of haulers.
 - c) Drop off at [Solid Waste Operations](#) (\$37.50/ton or flat rate for qualifying vehicles).
