Flags

United States flags

* Please do not throw an unwanted flag in the trash.
The [U.S Flag Code](#) outlines the proper way for old flags to be disposed.
The organizations listed below will follow these procedures.

1. **Drop off** an unwanted flag at a local flag retailer for appropriate ceremonial disposal at no charge:

2. **Donate** an unwanted flag to a local patriotic organization for appropriate ceremonial disposal, such as a:
 - a) [Boy Scouts troop](#)
 - b) [Girl Scouts troop](#)
 - c) Veterans organization such as [American Legion](#), [Amvets](#) or [VFW](#) (also see "Veterans & Military Organizations" in the Yellow Pages)
3. **Mail** an unwanted flag to [Flag Keepers](#), 349-L Copperfield Blvd #105, Concord, NC 28025, for proper disposal (\$5 fee per flag is waived for small handheld flags such as those used for grave markers, or for individuals who cannot afford to pay).
