### Flares, marine

signaling devices used on boats



**These are hazardous waste. Do NOT dispose with regular trash!  
It is illegal to throw used flares in household or business trash.**

1. Drop off expired or unneeded flares at a Pinellas County [mobile collection](#) or the [HEC<sub>3</sub> facility](#) for recycling (free for residents).
2. **Drop off** flares at a designated Clean Marina in the flare collection bucket for recycling (check with Harbor/Dock Master for location of bucket):
