Fuel

*diesel, gasoline, heating oil, boat fuel, kerosene, mixed fuels
— clean or contaminated —*



This is hazardous waste. Do NOT dispose with regular trash, pour down the drain, or on the ground!

1. **Drop off** at a Pinellas County [mobile collection](#) or the [HEC₃ facility](#) for recycling (free for residents).
 - a) Do not smoke while transporting fuel.
 - b) Fuel must be in an approved fuel container that does not exceed 5 gallons.
 - c) If you are bringing more than 5 gallons total, call first (464-7500).

2. **Businesses** can drop off fuels (for a [fee](#)) at a Pinellas County [mobile collection](#) or an [EnviroBusiness Day](#) event at the HEC₃ facility. Another option is to contact a fuel recycler directly to request pickup (fee varies):
