Fuel Tanks

metal tanks for liquid fuel such as oil, gasoline, or kerosene



These are hazardous waste. Do NOT dispose with regular trash.

1. **Return** to the fuel oil distributor (see decal or name stamped on the tank).
2. **Sell** to a scrap metal dealer that accepts empty fuel tanks. The tanks must be empty, cut in half, washed clean, and dry:

3. *City of St. Petersburg residents:* St. Petersburg will pick up fuel oil or propane tanks at no charge for those residents who pay for garbage service (limit 2). Tank must be empty with plug and valve removed. Call 893-7398 to request a pickup.

4. **Business options:**

- a) **Sell** to a scrap metal dealer (see #2 above).
- b) **Contact** a company that picks up and recycles tanks. The tank may be empty or full, and may be under or above ground (fee varies):

5. **Dispose** at [Solid Waste Operations](#) (\$37.50/ton or flat rate for qualifying vehicles):

- a) Tanks 100 gallons or less – Must be empty and rinsed with one end opened.
- b) Tanks over 100 gallons – Call 464-7500 for acceptance criteria.
- c) Depending on size, tanks may need to be cut in half.
