Gas Cans

*small metal or plastic container used to store gasoline for home use
such as for lawn mowers or generators*



**These are hazardous waste. Do NOT dispose with regular trash.
EMPTY cans are safe to dispose in the trash.**

1. **Reuse** the can, or give it away.
2. **Dispose** EMPTY, clean cans with cap removed in regular trash.
3. **Drop off** cans with gasoline inside at a Pinellas County [mobile collection](#) or the [HEC₃ facility](#) for recycling (free for residents).
 - a) Do not smoke while transporting gasoline.
 - b) Gasoline must be in an approved fuel container that does not exceed 5 gallons.
 - c) If you are bringing more than 5 gallons total, call first (464-7500).
4. **Businesses** can drop off gas cans (for a [fee](#)) at a Pinellas County [mobile collection](#) or an [EnviroBusiness Day](#) event at the HEC₃ facility.
