Steel Cans

clean, empty steel (“tin”) cans used for soup, vegetables, etc.

1. **Reuse** for storage or craft projects.
2. **Recycle** at [curbside or drop-off](#).
3. **Sell** to a metal recycler. Please call first to ask about minimum requirements.

5. **Business options:**
 - a) **Sell** cans to a metal recycler (see #3 above).
 - b) **Recycle** cans at a municipal drop-off site. See [Recycling Map](#), and click on a map number for a list of items accepted.
 - c) **Request** on-site recycling service. See [ABC List](#) of on-site recyclers that collect multiple items, including steel cans.
