Boil Water Advisory

On September 12, 2006, an interruption in water service occurred on 44th Avenue (off Gulf Blvd.) in the Belle Vista subdivision of St. Pete Beach. All necessary repairs were made properly and immediately. Pinellas County Utilities has issued a boil water advisory for residents in the entire Belle Vista subdivision (*see map on back*). This boil water advisory will be in effect for a minimum of 48 hours or until satisfactory analytical results are obtained. Customers will be notified when the boil water advisory is rescinded.

Boil Water Recommendations

1. All water used for drinking and cooking should be boiled.
2. A rolling boil of one to three minutes is sufficient.
3. This "boil water notice" will remain in effect until the problem has been corrected and a bacteriological survey shows that the water is safe to drink.
4. We will notify you immediately upon clearance.
