

Countdown to Completion

The Gulf Boulevard Construction Project is 90 percent complete and currently ahead of schedule. The roadway and the associated utilities construction are essentially finished south of 200th Avenue, with only the final coloring of the sidewalk portion and final striping remaining.

All new sewer lines have been installed and the existing lines have been rehabilitated with new liners. All potable water lines are installed and the reclaimed lines and service connections have been completed. The new stormwater drainage outfalls are ready for the rainy season. Less than a handful of the 31 new PSTA bus stops remain to be completed and the pedestrian crossing at Tiki Gardens is complete. New road signs have been installed along the majority of the project's length.

Work continues on the road shoulders between 200th Avenue and 1st Street North, and the permeable asphalt is progressing north from 200th Avenue to Walsingham Road. The guardrails are slated to be installed in the next few weeks and 28 parking spaces have been allocated along the seawall section of Gulf Boulevard.
