

## Telephone Notification 9/12/06

Please stand by for an important message from Pinellas County Utilities about your water.

This morning, an 8-inch water main break occurred on 44th Avenue (off Gulf Blvd.) in St. Pete Beach. This caused an interruption in water service for homes in the Belle Vista subdivision. Repairs have been made. Once your water comes back on, Pinellas County Utilities has issued a mandatory boil water notice. This means **do not drink water unless you boil it first**. This "boil water advisory" will be in effect for a minimum of 48 hours. Until the advisory is lifted, you should boil any tap water before drinking it, or substitute bottled water. This includes water used for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth, preparing food, or washing dishes. Keep the water at a rolling boil for 1-3 minutes. **You will be notified when you no longer need to boil your water.** If you have questions, please call 727-464-4000.
