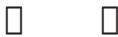


Fluoridated Water in Pinellas County Part Two of a Series

FAQs Frequently Asked Questions

Q ▶ What level of fluoride will be added?

A ▶ Natural fluoride levels in Pinellas County water currently range from an average of 0.15-0.25 parts per million (ppm)*. Water fluoridation will adjust the natural fluoride concentration in Pinellas County's drinking water to 0.8 ppm, a level recommended for optimal dental health in our climate.



* parts per million, ppm, is equivalent to one cent in \$10,000

FAQs

Q ▶ Should my child continue taking fluoride supplements?

A ▶ The Florida Department of Health recommends that prescription dietary fluoride supplements should not be given to any child who lives or goes to school in a fluoridated water community. However, you should consult the pediatrician or dentist who prescribed the supplement before making any decisions.
