When you install a shallow well, deep irrigation well or surface water withdrawal system, Pinellas County Utilities **Alternate Water Sources Rebate Program** will offer qualified water customers rebates up to \$300! Program participants must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- Receive their water from Pinellas County Utilities or from an approved municipality that purchases water wholesale from the County.
- Currently unable to receive reclaimed water.
- Not scheduled to receive reclaimed water within the next five years.
