Hazardous Electronics and Chemicals

Got unwanted hazardous electronics and chemicals around your home or garage? Drop them off at the **Pinellas County Utilities Household Electronics and Chemical Collection Center (HEC₃)**. The HEC₃ is a permanent, year-round facility with convenient hours of operation:

Monday, Tuesday, Friday	6:30 am – 4:30 pm
Wednesday	CLOSED
Thursday	8:00 am – 6:00 pm
3 rd Sat. of every month	7:00 am – 4:00 pm

While you're at the HEC₃, pick up usable household products such as paint, cleaners, and automotive fluids at the Swap Shop. All drop off and Swap Shop services at the HEC₃ are **FREE** for residents. The HEC₃ is located at 2990 - 110th Ave. N. in St. Petersburg (off 28th St. N.) BELLEAIR PIPELINE PROJECT

Pinellas County Utilities (PCU) will begin a year-long pipeline construction project this summer. The new Belleair pipeline will convey wastewater from a new pump station in the Town of Belleair to the PCU South Cross Bayou Water Reclamation Facility. A parallel pipeline will also be constructed to bring reclaimed water back to the Town of Belleair. The pipeline project will extend seven miles from Ponce de Leon Blvd. south to Park Blvd. along the Pinellas Trail. The Pinellas Trail will remain open during this project with minimal disruption to Trail users.
