Dirt

soil or earth

Clean, non-contaminated dirt:

1. **Reuse** or **sell**.
2. **Donate** clean fill dirt:
 - a) Use [Freecycle](#)—Sign up for a local group (Clearwater, Clearwater Beach, North Pinellas, Largo, or St. Petersburg), and create a listing.
 - b) Use [Craigslist Free Stuff](#)—Select “post” to create a listing.
3. **Dispose** at a local [rubble recycler](#).
4. **Dispose** at [Solid Waste Operations](#) (\$37.50/ton or flat rate for qualifying vehicles).

Contaminated dirt:

1. **Contact** Solid Waste at 464-7500 for information on required testing.
2. If testing shows that contamination is **within acceptable limits**, dispose at [Solid Waste Operations](#) (\$37.50/ton or flat rate for qualifying vehicles).
3. If testing shows that contamination **exceeds acceptable limits**, contact a thermal soil treatment company:
