### Fencing

*fence materials such as chain link, wood panels, or gates*

1. **Reduce** waste by repairing the fence if possible instead of buying a new one (see “Fence-Repairing” in the Yellow Pages).
2. **Reuse** fencing for indoor or outdoor projects:
  - a) landscaping bed
  - b) walkway
  - c) storage box
  - d) enclosure for heat pump or garbage cans
  - e) chandelier, rolling basket, or wall basket (see [HGTV](#))
  - f) bench, table, or shelving (see [Trash2Treasure](#))
  - g) NOTE: Pressure treated wood contains chemicals, and should not be recycled as yard waste or burned.
3. **Sell** or **donate** usable fencing:
  - a) Neighbor, friend, local church, etc.
  - b) [Building material recycler](#)
  - c) [Metal recycler](#) (*metal fencing only*). NOTE: [Precision One Mobile Recycling](#) offers fence removal and pickup (657-9556).
  - d) [Craigslist For Sale](#) or [Craigslist Free Stuff](#)—Select “post” to list your fencing.
  - e) Use [Freecycle](#)—Sign up for a local group (Clearwater, Clearwater Beach, Largo, North Pinellas, or St. Petersburg), and list your fencing.
  - f) Free newspaper ads—[St. Petersburg Times](#) (3 lines) or [Tampa Bay Newspapers](#) (15 words).
4. **Dispose:**
  - a) Residents living in municipalities, see [Bulk Item Disposal by Municipality](#)
  - b) Residents not living in municipalities, see [Bulk Item Disposal for Unincorporated Areas](#)
  - c) Drop off at [Solid Waste Operations](#) (\$37.50/ton or flat rate for qualifying vehicles).
