### Glass

*items made of glass including bottles, jars, windows, and doors*

1. **Reuse** glass bottles or jars for storage, leftovers, vases, or display.
2. **Recycle** empty glass bottles and jars:
  - a) Municipal [curbside or drop-off programs](#) (listed by city)
  - b) [Target store](#) (recycling bins located inside the store near the registers):
    - Palm Harbor: Boot Ranch, 900 E. Lake Rd., (786-6969)
    - Clearwater Mall: 2747 Gulf to Bay Blvd. (431-0231)
    - Largo Mall: 10500 Ulmerton Rd. (581-6000)
    - Pinellas Park: 7150 US Hwy. 19 N. (803-0022)
    - St. Petersburg: 4450 Park St. N. (548-0400)
    - St. Petersburg: 8151 Dr. MLK Jr. St. N. (576-2735)
3. **Recycle** glass windows or doors (unbroken) at a [building material recycler](#).
4. **Recycle** scrap glass—plate or cullet—at [Strategic Materials](#), 6420 -19<sup>th</sup> St. E., Sarasota (941-758-7773 or [e-mail](#)). Drop-off or pick-up (roll off containers) available. Call for current fees.
5. **Business** options:
  - a) See #3-4 above.
  - b) **Recycle** bottles or jars at a [recycling drop-off site](#).
  - c) **Request** on-site recycling service. See [ABC List](#) of on-site recyclers that collect multiple items, including glass.
