Newspapers

loose, dry newspapers and inserts

1. **Reuse:**
 - a) Share with a friend, neighbor, or co-worker
 - b) Use for packing material (shipping or storage)
 - c) Donate to an [animal shelter](#) to line cages.
2. **Recycle** at [curbside or drop-off](#).
3. **Recycle** at an [SP Recycling fundraising bin](#) (over 300 drop-off sites).
4. **Fundraising:** Schools or non-profit organizations can raise money by contacting [SP Recycling](#) (507-0777) to request a free bin.
5. **Business options:**
 - a) **Donate** to an [animal shelter](#) to line cages.
 - b) **Recycle** at a municipal drop-off site. See [Recycling Map](#), and click on a map number for a list of items accepted.
 - c) **Recycle** at an [SP Recycling fundraising bin](#).
 - d) **Request** on-site recycling service. To recycle multiple items, see [ABC List](#) for on-site recyclers that collect newspapers and other items.
 - e) **Request** on-site recycling from a company that collects paper products only:
