Paperboard

*dry single-layer paper packaging such as:
cereal boxes, cracker boxes, tissue boxes, gift boxes, shoe boxes,
paper egg cartons, and empty paper towel or toilet paper rolls
(NO waxed or foil-coated cartons such as milk or juice)*

1. **Reuse** for mailing or storage.
2. **Donate** usable items for reuse in craft projects. Call first.
 - a) school: [public](#) or [private](#)
 - b) [preschool or child care center](#)
 - c) [church or synagogue](#)
 - d) [recreation center](#)
3. **Recycle** at [curbside or drop-off](#) with “mixed paper”.
