## RECYCLING GUIDELINES

**No plastic bags please!**

**Aluminum Cans** – Empty aluminum cans used for drinks or food (such as soda or cat food cans). Rinse and crush if possible.

**Cardboard** – Clean, empty, dry corrugated (3-layer) cardboard boxes or packaging. Please flatten boxes. No pizza boxes.

**Newspapers** – Clean and dry newspapers (including inserts). No string or twine. It's okay to put them inside a paper bag.

**Plastic Bottles** – Empty plastic bottles with a “neck” (opening smaller than the base) such as water, soda, shampoo, or ketchup bottles. No need to check for #1 or #2—just “check for a neck”. Bottles only; no tubs, cups, or bags. Labels okay. No caps or lids. Rinse and crush if possible.
