

Beach Recycling Pilot

Pinellas County is piloting recreational recycling at public access beach sites. You can now recycle conveniently at the beach. If you visit one of the beach access sites chosen for the pilot, please recycle!



Project Description

Recycling these materials should reduce the volume of beach waste from the three sites by more than 25%, based on a recent waste composition study. The study will be repeated toward the end of the pilot to determine what percentage of the recyclable materials is actually being put in the recycling bins.

The beach recycling pilot program was designed to evaluate level of use, public acceptance, costs, service and maintenance, contamination, and different types and placement of recycling containers.

A survey of beach goers will help evaluate public preferences and reaction to the program. Survey questions will relate to how clear the recycling instructions are, whether the containers are noticeable and convenient, whether beach visitors have ideas for program improvements, and their general willingness to recycle while at the beach.

The data generated through the Pilot Program will be used to help determine the feasibility of continuing and/or expanding recycling programs at County beach parks. The report will also be provided to other municipalities throughout the State of Florida to assist them in developing and implementing beach and park recycling programs.

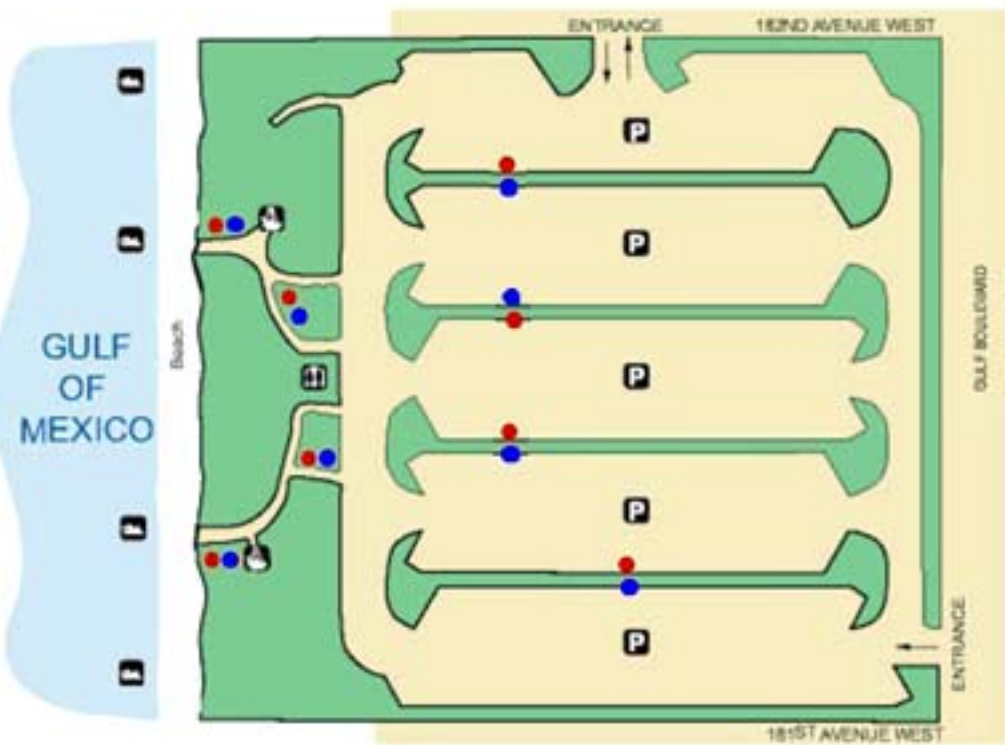

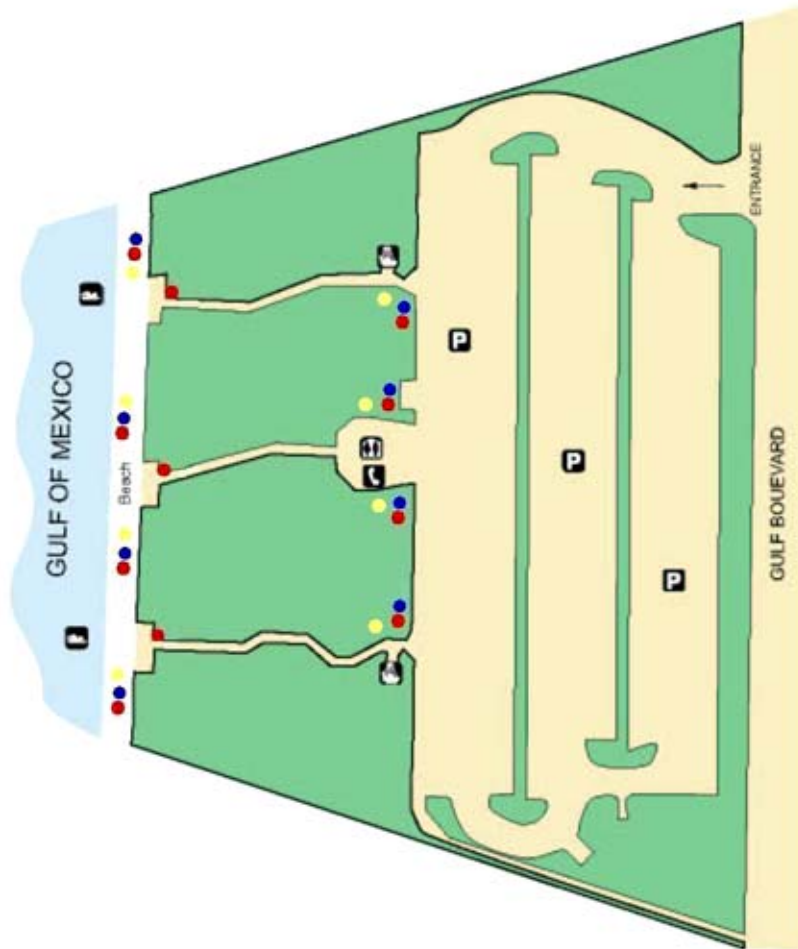

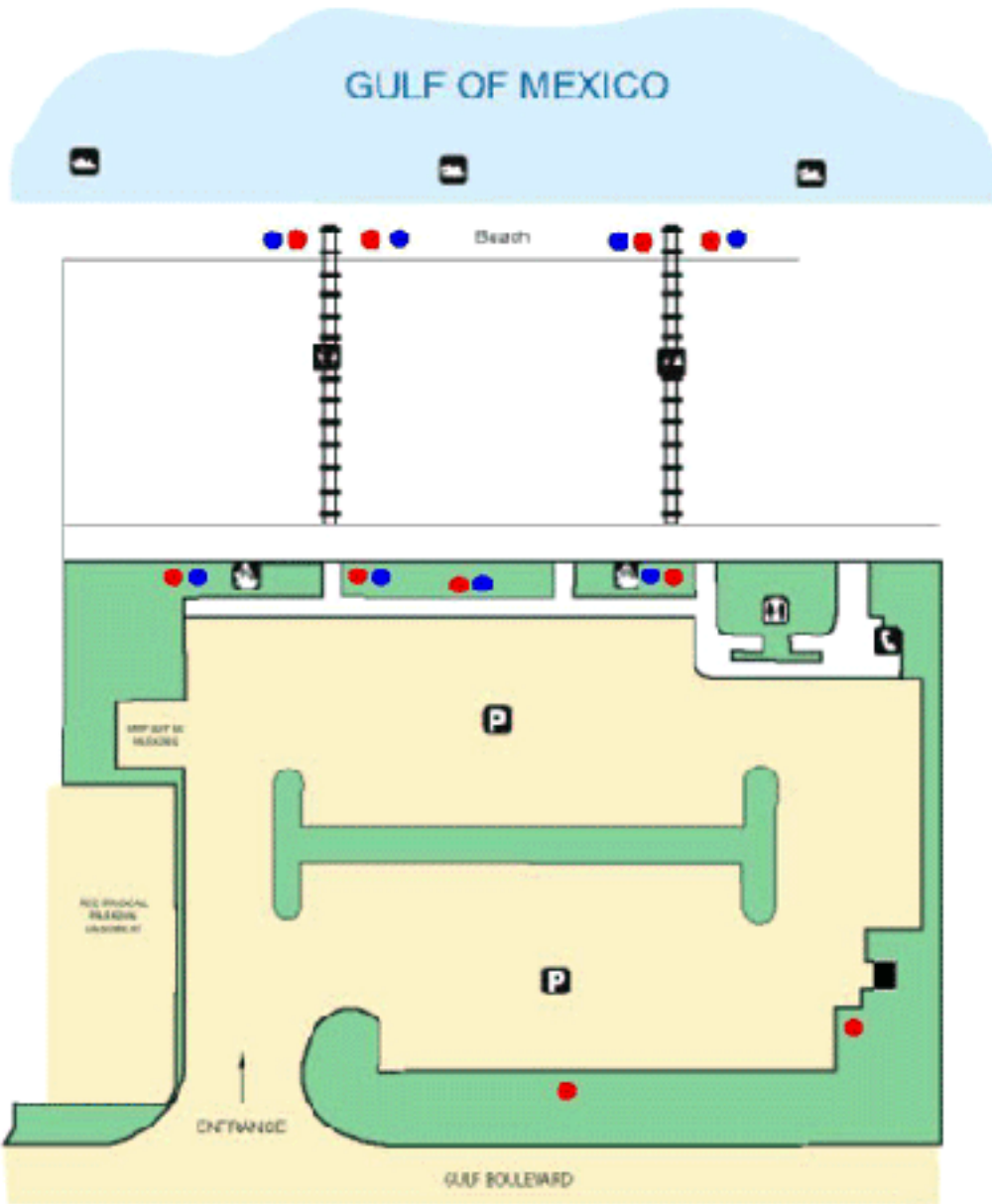
