



Conservation Challenge

The **Conservation Challenge** worksheet is recommended for grades K-5. The worksheet provides pictures to color, and 15 examples of conservation. There are five examples each of saving water, wasting water, and recycling. The answers are printed on the back of the worksheet. Younger students can color the pictures and locate some of the simpler examples such as the recycling bin in the kitchen. Older students should be able to identify some of the more difficult examples such as watering the car on the lawn saves water and flushing a tissue wastes water.
