<b>Position (Non-Paid):</b>	<b>Transportation Engineering Intern</b>

<b>Duties:</b>	<p>This summer internship position will provide college engineering students an opportunity to gain real-world experience in their field while working with a team of Public Works professionals. Students will conduct research and investigations to assist with roadway design, traffic operations or computerized transportation systems operations. Students may apply as part time or full time interns for a short term (2 weeks – 3 months) or for a long term (3 months +).</p> <p>Typical assignments may include transportation research, cost estimation, field reviews and information tracking, infrastructure design using AutoCAD and/or GIS, computerized signal system operations and studies, and assistance with a variety of tasks on civil, transportation, stormwater and environmental projects.</p>
