The Guides' ease of use is essential. Other activities could include assistance with meetings, activations, training, outreach and other areas. You will have a direct impact on the health and safety of the county's population.</p> <p>This intern will get a detailed look at the procedures following a hurricane or other disaster and, as an emergency management team member, you will have full access to the same training that the staff receives, can be involved in emergency activations and avail yourself of the many education opportunities within the department.</p>
