

Pinellas County Solid Waste Complex Information Sheet

SCALEHOUSE HOURS

- Open Monday–Friday 6 a.m.-6 p.m. and Saturday 7 a.m.-5 p.m.
- Closed Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day

Disposal fee: **\$39.75 per ton**

Requires deposit of 50% of total loaded vehicle weight. Credit/debit card deposits may be held for 3-5 business days based on policy of issuing bank.

FLAT FEES

The flat fee is not available if modifications have been made to the vehicle (*including sidewalls*)

- Pickup trucks & vans **\$10/load**
- Cars **\$3/load**

TIRE FEES

- Less than 5 tires charged at fees above
- 5 or more tires weigh in and out at..... **\$75.00/ton**
- Mixed loads containing tires..... **\$75.00/ton**
- Tires up to 36": Accepted whole
- Tires over 36": Must be cut into quarters
- Up to 4 tires can be attached to rim; all others must have rim removed

SPECIAL FEES (In addition to per ton fee)

- Special Handling Service Fee **\$110**
- Contractor Surcharge **\$100**

OUT OF COUNTY WASTE..... \$79.50/ton

ACCEPTED PAYMENT METHODS

- Cash or credit/debit cards–Visa or MasterCard only
- Checks–excluding starter checks, out-of-state personal checks, or two-party checks

REQUIRED PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:

- Closed-toed shoes to be worn on site

If going to the Waste-to-Energy facility or landfill, you must wear:

- Durable work boots
- Hard hat
- Safety glasses
- Safety vest

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Biological and infectious waste
- Explosives
- Gasoline or fuel oil
- Hazardous waste
- Liquid waste
- Radioactive waste

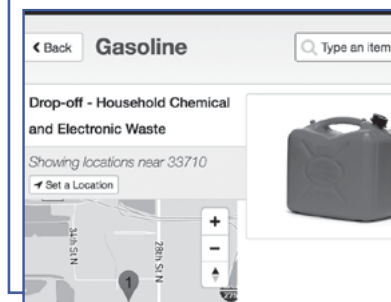
